







<u>Thumbs up, Thumbs Down</u> <u>— Helping Wild Animals</u>

<u>Tally Marks - I'm Going</u> <u>on a Bug Hunt</u>





National Parks Accordion Book


- Derived Print Pages 2-3, single sided only.
- \Box Cut in half a 12 x 18 inch construction paper lengthwise in any color you like. The final dimensions should be 6 x 18 inches.
- \Box Give your child a 6 x 18 inch piece of construction paper and show him or her how to fold the paper into fourths.
- □ Write the page number in pencil on the center of each square. The following numbers indicate the order in which the pages should be glued into the book.



- Discuss each page in the mini book and complete the activities. After all pages have been finished, carefully cut out each page and glue onto the construction paper.
- Allow construction paper to dry completely before folding the book into an accordion shape.

Cover of Book






Open the accordion book and follow the page numbers until you get back to the beginning.
